

SECURING THE FUTURE

Our exciting capital development plans encourage us to think of the future, and what Cathedral Isle of Man will be achieving in the next decade, century and beyond.

Through this process of designing and delivering the new facilities, we have been led to consider their on-going operation, and as such have implemented a comprehensive sustainability plan to ensure the continued life of the Cathedral for future generations.

In order to realise long-term sustainability, we need to create a substantial endowment fund of at least £3 million, the annual yield from which will pay for the operational, maintenance and additional staffing costs that enable the Cathedral to serve the Island community and visitors alike.

CATHEDRAL FABRIC

The capital programme for Worship Space covers all elements of urgent restoration and repair to the Cathedral fabric. However, quinquennial inspections on an ageing building will, without doubt, highlight required works that must be completed to maintain its structural health. The endowment will provide income to fund these critical repairs.

MUSIC & EDUCATION

The new Cloister development will house a first-class Song School for use by the Cathedral Choristers in addition to visiting schools and choirs. However, in order to achieve musical excellence, we must have the capacity to deliver professional training and guidance, both vocally and instrumentally. The endowment will provide the income to offer specialist choral and instrumental training to our choristers, to increase our outreach work to Island schools and support other community music initiatives.



THE LEAGUE OF ST GERMAN

The first Bishop and Patron of our Cathedral was a Celtic missionary who came to the Island in the Fifth century – Noo Carmane, otherwise known as St German. An early 16th century Ballad tells of him planting a Keeill (chapel) in every Treen (district), on the Island. He also built the first Cathedral at Peel where he was eventually buried. In the 19th century, the Cathedral stood in ruins. Inspired by Celtic saints, Archibald Knox designed beautiful silverware for Liberty's of London. Three of his finest pieces are in today's

Cathedral Treasury but were created for the restored ancient Cathedral. Knox created the League of St German to repair the ancient Cathedral, becoming its temporary Prior while the project was underway and encouraging philanthropy from his supporters. To commemorate the vision of our Founder and one of the greatest designers of the 20th century, all those who make committed gifts towards the work of this mother church will become members of The League of St German - a special group of people with a shared vision for the future.

CATHEDRAL FABRIC £-gift of any size

Endow the cost of music in the Cathedral on a chosen day in perpetuity - An excellent way to remember a loved one.

Inspiring youngsters in their musical training and nurturing the church musicians of the future.

ENDOW THE ORGAN SCHOLARSHIP £100,000/ single gift or £5,000 a year

Providing the opportunity for a talented musician to build on their skills in a supporting environment whilst contributing to the musical life of the Cathedral.

ENDOW THE LEADERSHIP £300,000/single gift or £15,000 a year

Funding the staffing costs of our music professionals who deliver first-class training and guidance to the budding young musicians in our Cathedral.
